MEMORANDUM OPINION

**Before Justices Contreras, Benavides, and Longoria
Memorandum Opinion by Justice Contreras**

Appellant, Oscar Enrique Mendez, M.D., perfected an appeal from a judgment entered by the 275th District Court of Hidalgo County, Texas, in cause number C-8356-14-E. Appellant has filed an amended unopposed motion to dismiss the appeal on

grounds that he no longer desires to pursue the appeal. Appellant requests that this Court dismiss the appeal.

The Court, having considered the documents on file and appellant's amended unopposed motion to dismiss the appeal, is of the opinion that the motion should be granted. See TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a).
