MEMORANDUM OPINION

Before Chief Justice Valdez and Justices Contreras and Hinojosa Memorandum Opinion by Chief Justice Valdez

Appellant, Ruth Cabrera, filed an appeal from a judgment entered by the County

Court at Law No. 1 of Hidalgo County, Texas, in cause number CL-13-2948-A. This

cause is before the Court on appellant's unopposed motion to dismiss the appeal on
