MEMORANDUM OPINION

Memorandum Opinion by Chief Justice Contreras**

Appellant, Ysidro Arismendez III, perfected an appeal from a judgment rendered on January 17, 2020. On March 30, 2020, the Clerk of the Court notified appellant that he was delinquent in remitting a \$205.00 filing fee.
