MEMORANDUM OPINION
PER CURIAM

Appellant pleaded guilty to assault on a family or household member by impeding breathing or circulation. His sentence was imposed on July 25, 2011.

We have received the trial court's certification showing that this is a plea bargain case and Appellant has no right to appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 25.2(d). The certification is signed by Appellant and his trial counsel. Therefore, this court does not have jurisdiction of the appeal, and the appeal must be dismissed. Accordingly, the appeal is *dismissed for want of jurisdiction*.
