Curtis Edward Boddie appeals a decision of the Workers' Compensation Commission that ruled he failed to prove he sustained an injury by accident arising out of his employment on September 8, 2004. Accordingly, we affirm the commission's decision for the reasons stated by the commission in its final opinion. See Boddie v. We dispense with oral argument and summarily affirm because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before the Court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
