Frank Pregano appeals a decision of the Workers' Compensation Commission finding that he failed to prove under Code § 65.2-401 that he sustained a compensable permanent hearing loss in his left ear by clear and convincing evidence. We have reviewed the record and the commission's opinion and find that this appeal is without merit. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the commission in its final opinion. See Pregano v. United Airlines, Inc., VWC File No. 226-29-38 (Sept. 17, 2007).
